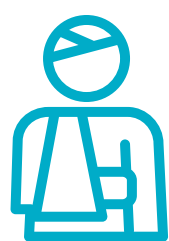


Workplace Injury & Death

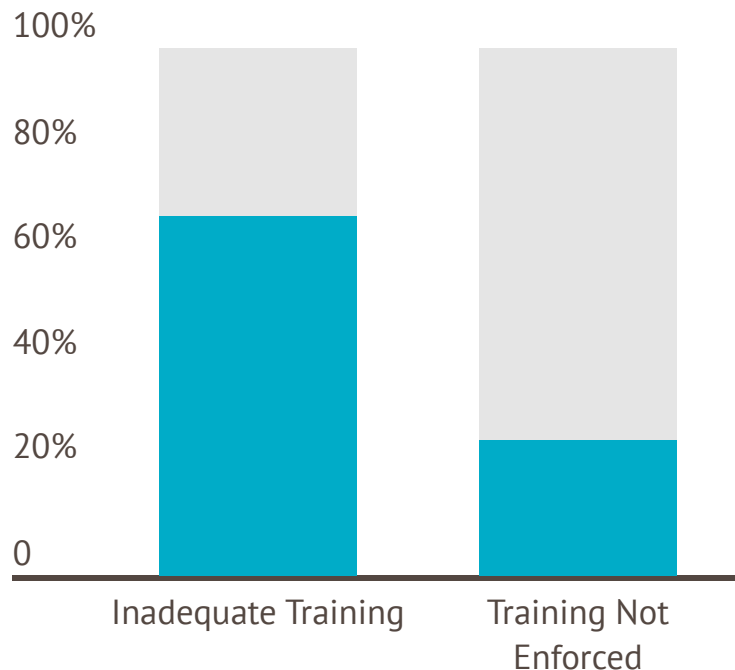

Two Key Causes

Inadequate and unenforced training are leading causes of preventable workplace accidents and fatalities. Research shows as much as **68%** of fatality cases in the US were because of inadequate training procedures and **26%** because such training was not enforced.
